Though not always the most enjoyable part of a project, it's an ethic and skill that we try to improve in our organization and for the young people we serve. Our recent strategic planning felt like a bit of a slog at times, not unlike scraping away layers of old paint or weeding and prepping garden beds in the spring—you know something beautiful is right around the corner but the work at hand feels, well, ponderous.

As a staff and board, one of the primary intentions that came out of this process was to bring even more youth and community to the treasure that is April Hill Conservation and Education Center. Owners and stewards since 2019, Greenagers already brings over 500 folks here annually but that feels like we're just scratching the surface. We want more kids, more school groups from near and far, more community programming—to share all that comprises April Hill.

We would not be here but for Mary Margaret Kellogg's vision of April Hill as an education space. More specifically, she called it a "healing place," a term that our Property Manager, Leslie, has taken to using and is fast becoming part of our vernacular here. My mind perched in a more clinical space with this word, healing, until I looked up the etymology of "heal": to make whole. It seems to me that there is a great deal of need for wholeness these days.

We certainly don't aim or claim to make everyone whole that comes to April Hill or participates in Greenagers programming, but I reckon that everyone leaves a little more whole than when they arrived. Maybe they received a garden to grow vegetables, maybe they got a job and now have skills to bolster their self-worth, perhaps they split some firewood that will go to a deserving family. The opportunities for healing are myriad and they start with you, our donors, continue to our staff and community youth, and on to the community at large with beautiful trails, healthy food, and skillful and inspired youth. It's the whole circle. Thank you for adding your piece.

## A Plan for the Future

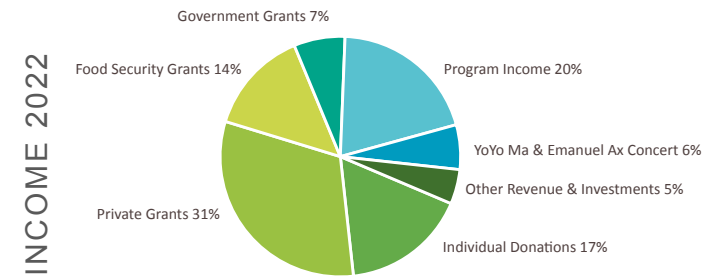

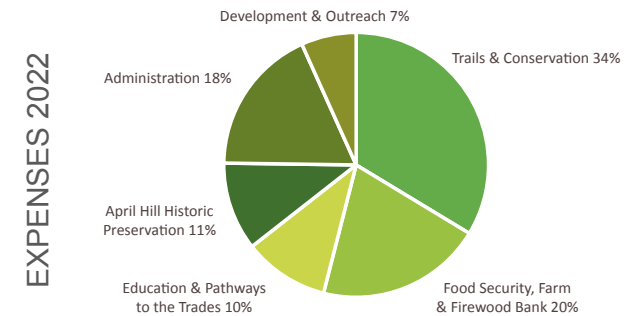
1. Maximize the impact of our programming for teens and young adults given our organization’s size and scale.

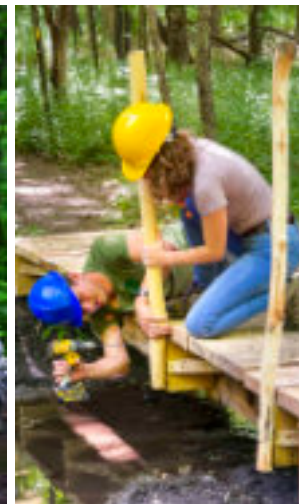

## Youth Make Municipalities More Resilient

Over the course of nine months, nine youth from Berkshire County were recruited, trained, and paid to survey waterways and road-crossing infrastructure for structural integrity, flood risk, and habitat connectivity. Working with project partners including the Housatonic Valley Association, Berkshire Regional Planning Commission, and the Towns of Stockbridge and Lenox, and City of Pittsfield, youth were trained and certified to measure and evaluate over 250 culverts and bridges -- all of the road-stream crossings in the towns of Stockbridge, Lenox, and Pittsfield. The product of this crew's work provides towns a better sense of what road-stream crossing infrastructure is most likely to wash out in extreme weather events and where there may be an opportunity to reconnect critical wildlife habitat.
